Multiple Intervenors is an organization dedicated to meeting the needs of its members. Multiple Intervenors' members share a common interest in ensuring that New York State's energy markets provide access to reliable, affordable energy supplies. Because Multiple Intervenors is the only party exclusively representing New York's large-volume energy consumers in

administrative, regulatory and judicial proceedings, Multiple Intervenors plays a critical role in advocating its members' interests, as well as shaping New

York State's energy policy. As part of its advocacy role, Multiple Intervenors also seeks to educate governmental and non-governmental entities responsible for energy matters on the cost impacts that their decisions will have on large energy consumers and New York's economy.



GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- * Advocate for utility rates that ensure adequate supply at the lowest reasonable cost.
- * Actively promote energy policies, laws and regulations that are fair to large energy consumers.
- * Advocate for wholesale energy market rules that produce equitable energy prices.
- * Channel Multiple Intervenors' diverse membership into one strong voice of influence on major issues affecting large energy consumers.
- * Provide members with updates on relevant State and federal initiatives affecting large energy consumers.
- * Assure that Multiple Intervenors' positions are considered as State and federal energy policies are crafted and administered.
- * Promote awareness of the impact of energy costs and power quality on large energy consumers.

PROVEN SUCCESS

- * In 2014, achieved tremendous success in the triennial Demand Curves reset process, administered by the NYISO, resulting in remarkable capacity price savings for members.
- * In 2012-2013, negotiated a favorable three-year rate plan involving Niagara Mohawk's electric and gas rates resulting in significant electric and gas cost savings for members, as well as the adoption of revenue allocations and rate designs more beneficial to members than what had been proposed in the rate proceeding.
- * In 2012-2013, negotiated a favorable resolution of the Central Hudson-Fortis merger proceeding that provided for approximately \$50 million in customer benefits, the adoption of strong financial and operational protections for customers related to the merger, and a two-year electric and gas rate freeze.
- * In 2013, negotiated a favorable resolution of an NFG gas rates proceeding providing for tens of millions of dollars in rate moderation, a customer refund, and a two-year rate freeze.
- * In 2009-2010, negotiated favorable electric and gas rate plans for NYSEG and RG&E that successfully eliminated and/or moderated the vast majority of delivery rate increases sought by the utilities, implemented revenue allocations and rate designs favorable to members, and ensured a period of general rate stability that still is in effect.
- * In 2010, successfully litigated against Niagara Mohawk's requested electric rate increase and secured victories that included a sharply-reduced revenue requirement, rejection of a highly-unfavorable revenue allocation, and the rejection of a proposal to extend stranded cost recovery for an additional three-year period.
